CHARLES HEIDSIECK

Charles-Camille Heidsieck set up his own champagne company in 1851. The pursuit of the highest quality was always the company's main aim. Based in Reims, it is one of the few houses that is able to use the fabulous chalk "crayères" – cellars under the city. The "crayères" were hollowed out during Gallo-Roman times so that the chalk could be used for building.

DELAMOTTE

It's in 1760, right in the middle of the intellectual, cultural, and scientific movement of the Enlightenment that Maison Delamotte was established in Reims by François Delamotte. Alexandre Delamotte brought the cellars, caves and offices of the House of Delamotte to a mansion at the end of the 18th century. In 1988, the House of Delamotte joined forces with the still enigmatic Champagne Salon.

Their vineyard sources are immaculate throughout the range: even Brut Classic notches up a 97% rating on the échelle des crus, and the house can call on a lavish selection of grands crus, including Avize, Le-Mesnil-sur-Oger, and Ay.
